There is a quiet force sustaining organised philately in South Africa – a backbone of support for the activities and services provided by the Philatelic Federation of South Africa (PFSA), and its operational committees. This backbone is the **Philatelic Foundation of Southern Africa**, a promotional body that was founded in 1975.

The PFSA is involved with the day to day wellbeing of the hobby of stamp collecting and is largely funded by the Foundation. Through this capital backing, collectors enjoy a variety of benefits as members of stamp societies.

How did this come about?

At the PFSA's initiative a three-man delegation (Manfred Weinstein RDPSA, Prof Casper Schutte and Joh Groenewald RDPSA) met with the Minister of Posts and Telegraphs, Marais Viljoen, in Pretoria in November 1973. The delegation suggested that the South African Post Office (SAPO), which profits from philatelic sales, should plough back with a grant to a public-private partnership fund administered by itself and organised philately. That historic meeting had other outcomes as well. It led to a grand prix award, the State President's Trophy, for National Philatelic Exhibitions as well as the Postmaster-General's Shield for the best South African exhibit.

At the next years' exhibition, SAPHIL 1974 in Pretoria, the minister confirmed SAPO's support and cooperation. The PFSA Executive Committee proposed the forming of a separate non-profit body in January 1975.

This was approved at the Paarl 1975 Philatelic Congress, with SAPO and the PFSA having equal representation on the new body, **The Philatelic Foundation of Southern Africa**.

A grant from SAPO allowed the Philatelic Foundation (*Filateliestigting*) to get started. Later, funds were augmented by making souvenir sheetlets depicting unaccepted Union of South Africa stamp designs available at national exhibitions. This was followed by miniature sheets having postal validity but sold at a premium for the Foundation. In 1994 the SAPO ceased its support. Foundation adopted a policy of using only part of its annual interest earnings towards the funding of current philatelic activities and re-investing the rest to grow the capital base.

The fund has grown to the extent that the Foundation could become a major funding partner, jointly with SAPO, of the 2010 Johannesburg Asian International Philatelic Exhibition.

On Foundation's role in South Africa's Philately the 2018 President Dr Jim Findlay RDPSA, at that year's National Exhibition, emphasized that the main object of the Foundation is *"To promote in every way whatsoever, including the collection of funds, their administration and application to the furthering of the cultural activity of Philately in South Africa"* and affirmed that the Foundation has become the essential backbone for organised stamp collecting in South Africa, which will continue to serve its objectives with prudence and responsibility.

FOREWORD BY THE PATRON FORMER PRESIDENT KGALEMA MOTLANTHE



As the Patron of this International Stamp Exhibition being hosted here in Cape Town, it is my honour and privilege to welcome you – delegates from the Fédération Internationale de Philatélie (FIP), delegates of the Philatelic Federation of South Africa, commissioners from various countries, dealers and stamp collectors - to our beautiful country and the Mother City of Cape Town.

Stamps were first issued in South Africa by the Cape Colony on 1 September 1853.

The two stamps that were issued were a one penny in brick-red and a four pence in blue. Some stamps, such as these triangular issues of the Cape of Good Hope, have become legendary. We are, therefore, elated, some 169 years after the first stamp was issued in the Cape Colony, to host this International Stamp Exhibition in the historic Mother City.

This event will feature 1 600 frames of stamps from all over the world, including a significant number of frames from South Africa. I have been made aware of the work that went into preparing these exhibits and acknowledge the incredible undertaking that this has been for the country, to host such an event, I applaud all of you for what you have achieved. I know that the judges will also play their role in judging the different categories in a fair and open manner.

As previously reported, the Organising Committee of the Cape Town International Stamp Exhibition decided that it will be appropriate to link this event with the theme “The Road to Democracy in South Africa”. This is based on the title of an Open Class collection that has been composed over the last 25 years reflecting on the path to democracy in South Africa. South Africans can be proud of what they have achieved on their “Road to Democracy”, commencing with the peaceful transition in 1994 that changed the course of South Africa’s history, thereby paving the way for a new democratic dispensation.

Philately and stamps have a critical role to play in contributing to this achievement, as an appreciation of history helps to provide multiple perspectives on how various elements come together to create societies or to build nations. These stamps and covers represent a thought-provoking aspect of South Africa’s at times painful past, in the same fashion that other international exhibits reflect on their own countries’ history.

A key aim of the International Stamp Exhibition in 2022 is, therefore, to generate interest for philately amongst a broader cross-section of South African society, and in that way to promote it as a hobby. A hobby that has, as a central theme, the appreciation of history. It is for this reason that we have also invited school children from diverse communities to attend the exhibition.

I would like to congratulate the Organising Committee of this event, under the leadership of Mr Emil Bührmann, for hosting this exhibition. I would also like to thank the Department of Communication and Technologies under Minister Khumbudzo Ntshavheni and the Deputy Minister Mr. Philly Mapulane, the South African Revenue Service, the SA Post Office, Philatelic Services and the SA Post Office Museum for their support .

May you all enjoy our legendary South African hospitality.

The Philatelic Federation of South Africa (PFSA) is a voluntary association organised as a federation of clubs & societies for stamp collectors and philatelists of all ages and all types.

PFSA serves as the umbrella body of stamp clubs and philatelic societies dedicated to the promotion of stamp collecting, study of all its facets, and the promotion of the interests of all its memberships.
